## ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The Indian Institute of Technology Madras is known both nationally and internationally for excellence in technical education, basic and applied research, innovation, entrepreneurship and industrial consultancy. A faculty of international repute, a highly motivated and brilliant student community, excellent technical and supporting staff and an effective administration have all contributed to the pre-eminent status of IIT Madras. The Institute is proud to bear the laureate of being No.1 engineering university in India. More recently, IIT Madras has been given the title of Institute of Eminence.

In 1956, the German Government offered technical assistance for establishing an institute of higher education in engineering in India. The first Indo-German agreement in Bonn, West Germany for the establishment of the Indian Institute of Technology at Madras was signed in 1959.

The Institute was formally inaugurated in 1959 by Prof. Humayun Kabir, Union Minister for Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs. The IIT system has sixteen Institutes of Technology – the first of these to be instituted were at Kharagpur (estb. 1951), Mumbai (estb. 1958), Chennai (estb. 1959), Kanpur (estb. 1959), Delhi (estb. 1961), Guwahati (estb. 1994) and Roorkee (estb. 1847, joined IITs in 2001).

## A GLOBALLY RECOGNIZED INSTITUTE

IIT Madras is a residential institute with nearly 550 faculty, 8000 students and 1250 administrative & supporting staff and is a self-contained campus located in a beautiful wooded land of about 250 hectares. The campus is located in the city of Chennai, previously known as Madras. Chennai is the state capital of Tamilnadu, a southern state in India.

The Institute has sixteen academic departments and a few advanced research centres in various disciplines of engineering and pure sciences, with nearly 100 laboratories organised in a unique pattern.

IIT Madras has been the top-ranked engineering institute in India for four consecutive years as well as the 'Best Educational Institution' in Overall Category in the NIRF Rankings of 2019 put out by the Ministry of Human Resource Development.

## SPORTS EXCELLENCE ADMISSION

Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IITM) is embarking on a new journey to admit students to her much-coveted undergraduate programs in recognition of their excellence in sports. The program is named as "Sports Excellence Admission (SEA)". The objective of SEA is to reward and encourage students who have achieved a certain level of excellence in sports of their choice.

*IIT Madras will be offering seats in each of its B.Tech. programs through SEA by the creation of two supernumerary seats per branch for Indian Nationals (as per the decision (dated February 03, 2023) passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) 891 / 2021, OCI/PIO candidates who have secured OCI/PIO card before 04.03.2021 shall be considered as Indian national, for the purpose of admission to IITs). The Sports Excellence Admission will be operational from the academic year 2024 – 2025. In a similar way, for the program BS (Medical Sciences and Engineering) two seats will be offered under SEA route.*

The number of seats available in the program are listed in the table below.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process for the regular BS (Medical Sciences and Engineering) programme has a provision to indicate for the candidates whether they should be considered under sports excellence admission or not. The candidates who have indicated this are shortlisted first. Their sports achievement documents are scrutinized first and the following process is used to compute their Sports Rank.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The candidate should satisfy ALL the following criteria to be eligible to apply for SEA to IIT Madras.

- A. The candidate should be an Indian national or an OCI/PIO card holder whose OCI/PIO card was issued before 04.03.20211.
- B. The candidate should be qualified in IAT (2024) and have obtained a rank in the Common Rank List (CRL) or category-wise rank list in IAT (2024). The position in the rank list may be in any of the categories for which rank lists are prepared, thereby ensuring that the benefits of reservations are not lost and the requisite academic requirement is not diluted.
- C. The candidate should have obtained the minimum required marks in class XII as per the eligibility criteria for IITs (Part-II clause 1 in page 8 of the Information Brochure (IB), BE (Medical Science and Engineering) 2024).
- D. Candidates should have obtained at least ONE medal in the last FOUR years (i.e., from 01 April 2020 to 31 March 2024) of sports achievements in any of the National/International level competitions, where the points are allocated as per the following table.

### SCORE COMPUTATION AND SPORTS RANK LIST (SRL)

A score will be assigned to each candidate based on their sporting performance. The score for each candidate will be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Score} = \sum_i W_i \times S_i$$

where  $W_i$  is the weightage of the  $i^{\text{th}}$  medal as shown in Appendix A or B.  $S_i$  is the points for the  $i^{\text{th}}$  medal according to the event and level as mentioned in Table 1. For example, if a person wins third place (bronze medal) in the Commonwealth Games and first place (gold medal) in the Khelo India Youth Games, then, the candidate's Score will be

$$0.9 \times 80 + 0.75 \times 35 = 98.25$$

The score thus obtained will be rounded off to two decimal places.

It is noted that the difficulty level of playing at an international level depends on the kind of sport. To normalize the competitions across various sports and the number of participants in a given sport/game, the following methodology will be adopted:

- Participation/Winning a medal at the international level will be considered only if at least SIX nations participate in the particular sport/game.
- Winning a medal at the national level will be considered only if the sport/game is played by at least 50% of the states in the competition.

The candidate scores will be treated the same for "Individual" or "Team Events." Tournaments (International and National) in sports disciplines recognized by the 58 federations recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS), Government of India, ONLY will be

considered for the award of points. The international and national events that will be considered for admission through SEA are listed in Appendix A and Appendix B in the order of their relative weightage.

A separate Sports Rank List (SRL) will be prepared based on the total score obtained by the candidates based on their performance in the specific list of sports mentioned in Appendix - C only. The seat allotment will be done based on SRL only. Mere presence in the SRL does not guarantee admission. In the event that there are candidates with the same score (computation detailed below), the following tiebreaking criterion will be adopted.

- Candidates with higher scores at the international level will be given higher rank.
- In case of a tie at the international level, a candidate with a higher score at the national level will be given a higher rank.
- In case of a tie at both international and national levels, the same rank will be given to all the candidates with a tie.

By this method, the candidate will be placed according to the performance in the sporting activities and thereby achieve the objective of encouraging excellence in sports.

The SRL rank of all the candidates will be displayed in the portal (accessible through their respective logins) along with Round 1 allotment.

## **SEAT ALLOTMENT**

The SEA mode of admission will have a time limit within which the students must submit their supporting documents in advance for verification. There will be only TWO ROUNDS of SEA seat allotment and the detailed schedule is given below.

For the academic year 2024-2025, the SEA will consider the scores obtained by the candidates in the list of sports mentioned in Appendix C only to ensure the availability of facilities at the admitting IIT so that the candidates can continue to excel in sports.

### **SEAT ACCEPTANCE FEE**

The candidates should pay a Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF) upon accepting the allotted seat. The seat acceptance fee is Rs. 35,000 for General, Gen-EWS and OBC-NCL category students and for all others, it is Rs. 17,500. The SAF, excluding a processing fee of Rs. 5,000 will be adjusted against the first-semester admission fee to be paid at the time of joining the institute. The SAF can be paid online using the payment gateway options provided on the SEA portal.
